Our Most Recent Public Meeting: Thursday, May 1, 2025 "Organic Lawn and Landscape Development"

Presenter: Mary Travaglini, Montgomery County Office of Environmental Protection

Ms. Travaglini's presentation highlighted key aspects of organic yard management. She noted that the benefits of organic lawn care include contributing to climate resilience by improving air quality, absorbing stormwater, and storing carbon; in addition, organic practices can reduce reliance on chemicals and protect pollinators and soil health. She also discussed programs and resources available to the public, including rainscapes.org for conservation landscaping rebates, Tree Montgomery free shade tree planting, and Montgomery County composting and soil testing tools. Attendees asked a range of questions on:

- Tick prevention and safer alternatives to pesticides
- Best practices for managing invasive plants and vines
- How to safely convert lawns to meadows
- Understanding soil pH and nutrient balancing
- Use of flame weeders in non-lawn areas
- Importance of visual "cues to care" (e.g., clean lawn edges) to avoid code complaints
