Following a brief statement from each candidate, audience questions will be taken. A short reception with the opportunity for you to speak informally with the candidates will follow.

Since the Montgomery County primary ballots (Democratic, Republican and Non-Affiliated) will have these Board of Education contests, this forum is significant for all voters who intend to cast their ballot on Primary Election Day.
